

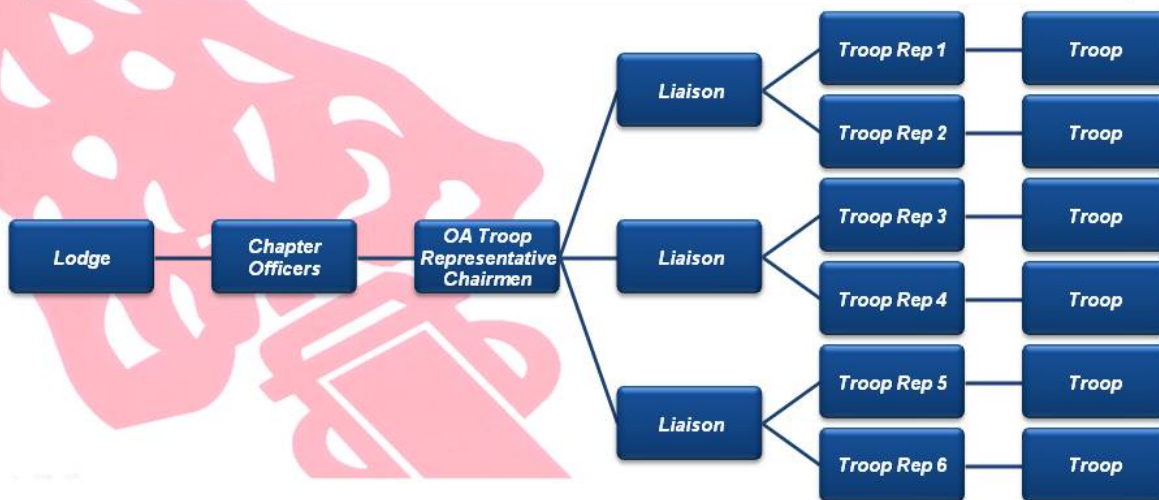

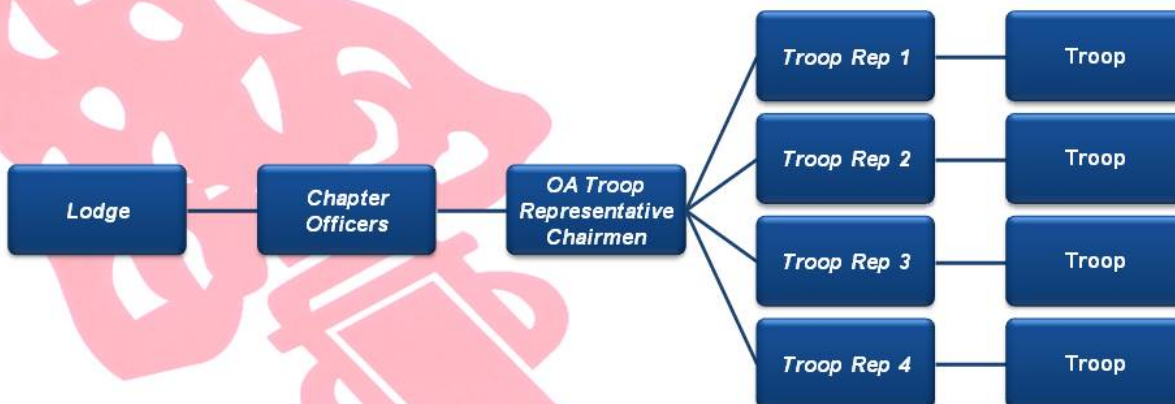
I. Communication Structures of the OA

- II. What is expected from the Chapters
 - a. To submit the OA Rep lists with the completed percentage by the dates specified in the Quality Chapter packet.
 - b. Submit any troops that you want deemed unreachable to the Lodge OA Rep Chairmen at least 2 weeks before the 100% deadline
 - c. Troops can get this designation for the following reasons:
 - i. Troop has no OA members
 - ii. The troop is no longer active
 - iii. **MULTIPLE** attempts have been made to contact the troop with no success and all routes for contact have been exhausted
 - iv. Some LDS troops do not participate
 - d. Remember that a troop only qualifies for this mark if they match the above criteria. Communication to your members is essential, so all means of communication should be used.
 - e. Your district executives often have the most up to date contact information for troops so make sure you talk with them if you are having some difficulties contacting a troop.
 - f. If you are in doubt if a troop meets these requirements, feel free to contact the Lodge troop rep chairmen. If you have a different situation, discuss it with the Lodge OA Rep chairmen and they will work something out.
 - g.
