

**CHAPTER:** Gravois Trail and Grand Towers  
**PROJECTS:** Camp Famous Eagle

Breakfast: Chapter Headquarters  
Lunch Spot: Famous Eagle council ring

1. Clear brush at lake's edge from boating area to Stark campsite.
2. Clear the marked area near Stark and Smith campsites for installation of a new floating bridge.
3. Designate 5 clans, 3 campsites per clan (1 clan will have 2 sites) to clear red and blue patrol sites. Clear brush and limbs around latrines.
4. Walk the perimeter line of the rifle range and clear brush, limbs, and small trees 3 feet on each side of the line.
5. Walk the perimeter line of the archery range and clear brush, limbs, and small trees 3 feet on each side of the line.
6. Clear five feet of brush around the staff showers and each of the Scout showers. Use caution when clearing around the propane tanks.
7. Clear brush in the first parking lot so that the parking area can be enlarged.

Equipment needs: bow saws, chain saw with safety gear

**Note:** Make sure chapter leadership at project has first aid kit and cell phone with emergency numbers.

Chain saw safety gear: chaps, helmet with ear and face protection

You must be 21 years old or older to operate a chain saw.  
You must be 18 years old or older to operate a weed eater.

**CHAPTER:** Boone Trails  
**PROJECTS:** South fence line – enter at the Sakima Field Sports Area

Breakfast: Chapter Headquarters  
Lunch Spot: Fence line  
Take lunch with you

1. Remove all brush, trees, and shrubbery along the fence line to allow a 10 foot path between fence line and tree line.
2. Trim trees that are not cut to a height of 10 feet.
3. Conduct minor repairs to any portion of the fence line that has fallen down.
4. Mark trees with purple paint and signage.

Equipment needs: bow saws, chainsaw with safety gear, purple paint, brushes, weed eaters with safety gear, hammers, nails, signs

Weed eater safety gear: ear and eye protection

**CHAPTER:** River Trails  
**PROJECTS:** Rand Circle

Breakfast: Astronauts' Hall  
Lunch Spot: Astronauts' Hall  
Project Leaders: Pat Martchink

1. Remove marked trees in the Rand Circle. Cut into appropriate lengths and split wood. Mulch limbs.
2. Clean out culverts in the Rand Circle.
3. Clear brush along fence line of the Ranch corral.
4. Clear marked areas along the west side of the camporee rock road between the Londe Adirondaks and the shotgun range to enlarge camping areas.

Equipment needed: bow saws, weed eaters with safety gear, chainsaw with safety gear,

Weed eater safety gear: ear and eye protection

Chain saw safety gear: chaps, helmet with ear and face protection

Mulcher: Must be 21 years old to operate mulch machinery

You must be 21 years old or older to operate a chain saw.  
You must be 18 years old or older to operate a weed eater.

**CHAPTER:** Osage  
**PROJECTS:** Swift Base

Breakfast: Chapter Headquarters  
Lunch Spot: Swift Pavilion

1. Clear brush 8' feet from road low water bridge to 15 yards past Swift sign.
2. Weed eat lagoon area.
3. Trim trees to keep limbs off of tent frames – staff row and campsites.
4. Remove marked trees from the area between the council ring stage and the lake.
5. Walk the perimeter of the rifle range and remove brush, limbs, and small trees 3 feet on each side of the wire perimeter.
6. Walk the perimeter of the horse corral and remove brush, limbs, and small trees 3 feet on each side of the wire perimeter.
7. Cut down and remove any dead trees in the horse corral.

Equipment needed: bow saws, weed eaters with safety gear, and chain saw with safety gear

**Note:** Make sure chapter leadership at project has first aid kit and cell phone with emergency numbers.

Weed eater safety gear: ear and eye protection

Adult leaders should assist with providing transportation to Swift Base.

**CHAPTER:** Pathfinder  
**PROJECTS:** Family Camp

Breakfast: Chapter Headquarters  
Lunch Spot: Family Camp Pavilion

1. Remove brush along designated areas of the Family Camp road.
2. Remove marked trees in Family Camp circle and area between cabins and the lake. Mulch trees and grind stump. Safety is important. Only individuals 21 years of age are allowed to use the mulcher, chainsaw, and stump grinder.
3. Clear low limbs in the area between the Family Camp road and the Family Camp beach.
4. Weed eat and cut brush back at lagoon.

Equipment needed: bow saws, weed eaters with safety gear, chainsaw with safety gear

**CHAPTER:** Ozark Trailblazers  
**PROJECTS:** Property Line at Hwy OO

Breakfast: Chapter Headquarters  
Lunch Spot: Property Line  
Take lunch with you

1. Clear brush, limbs, and small trees from property line fence.
2. Pick up trash from fence line.

Equipment needed: bow saws, chainsaw with safety gear, rakes, trash bags,  
coolers for lunches/drinks

**Note:** Make sure chapter leadership at project has first aid  
kit and cell phone with emergency numbers.

Chain saw safety gear: chaps, helmet with ear and face protection

You must be 21 years old or older to operate a chain saw.  
You must be 18 years old or older to operate a weed eater.

**CHAPTER:** North Star  
**PROJECTS:** Nims Overlook

Breakfast: Chapter Headquarters  
Lunch Spot: Nims Overlook Parking Lot

1. Remove brush along shoreline near tree houses.
2. Move rock from pile to underneath the tree houses.
3. Cut up down marked trees and haul into woods.
4. Weed eat and trim trees around Overlook plaque.
5. Clean back-side of dam of trees and brush. Safety is very important here. Clear 10' from edge of groins to middle. No need to haul it away let it lie.
6. Repair rock wall between plaque and parking lot.

Equipment needed: buckets, shovels, bow saws, weed eaters with safety gear,  
chainsaw with safety gear

**Note:** Make sure chapter leadership at project has first aid kit and cell phone with emergency numbers.

Chain saw safety gear: chaps, helmet with ear and face protection

**CHAPTER:** New Horizons  
**PROJECTS:** Camp Gamble

1. Designate 5 clans, 3 campsites per clan (1 clan will have 2 sites) to clear red and blue patrol sites. Clear brush and limbs around latrines.
2. Clear marked areas along road from main road to parking lot.
3. Clear brush back at least 3 feet along truck roads.
4. Clear marked trees on Moreno campsite for the Voyageur Area.
5. Cut brush, limbs, and small trees 3 feet along both sides of the perimeter line of the rifle and archery ranges.

Equipment needed: bow saws, weed eaters with safety gear, chainsaw with safety gear

Weed eater safety gear: ear and eye protection

Chain saw safety gear: chaps, helmet with ear and face protection

You must be 21 years old or older to operate a chain saw.  
You must be 18 years old or older to operate a weed eater.

**CHAPTER:** Thunderbird  
**PROJECTS:** Challenge Course

Breakfast: Chapter Headquarters  
Lunch Spot: Challenge Course

1. Clear brush and limbs along trails between the activities.
2. Move rock to various spots as instructed by the Challenge Course staff.
3. Trim and remove marked trees near White Oak Spring parking sign.

Equipment needed: bow saws, weed eaters with safety gear, chainsaw with safety gear, rakes, shovels, buckets, wheel barrels
